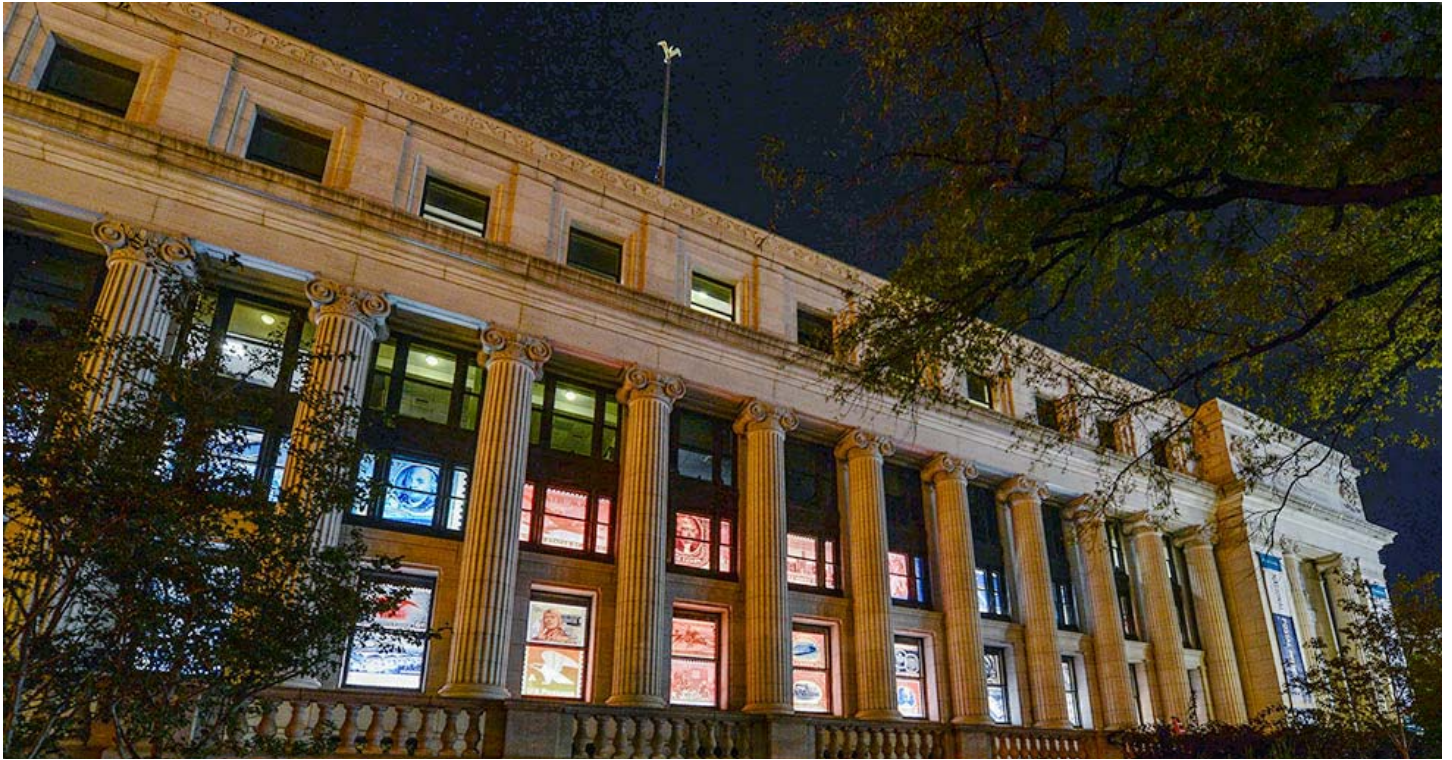


Project: Smithsonian Postal Museum William H. Gross Stamp Gallery Grand Opening 22nd September 2013
